BOROUGH OF LONGPORT COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES AUGUST 8, 2012

WORKSHOP @ 4:30 PM

The workshop session was called to order by Acting Clerk Strawder. The Sunshine Notice "The Downbeach Current and the Press of Atlantic City were notified of this meeting and same posted on the bulletin board in Borough Hall" was announced.

Roll Call: Mayor Russo, Commissioner's Leeds and Lawler were in attendance. Also in attendance were Solicitor Pat Agnellini and CFO Jenna Kelly.

Commissioner Leeds asked about the license agreement with Ocean Plaza. Mr. Agnellini replied that it had been completed and sent to them. Commissioner Leeds then asked about items list for a bond and Mr. Carter stated there is close to 13 million dollars worth of bondable items that is needed. Ms. Kelly stated there is an upgrade for police radios that is needed prior to Jan. 2013. The Mayor asked if Mr. Carter would explain the philosophy of the drainage on 34th Ave. Mr. Carter will prepare more information for the next meeting (August 25th). Mr. Leeds stated a packet will be put together for review.

Commissioner Leeds would like to discuss parking. The Mayor instructed the Clerk to get a list of residents who live on the affected streets (Colgate, Evergreen) and the Mayor will draft a letter stating that he is aware of the petition approx. three years ago that was anti-one side parking. He will ask that the residents review the letter from the Deputy Fire Chief along with photos that will show how difficult it is for emergency apparatus to navigate through those streets (Woodcrest, Colgate, Evergreen). Mr. Leeds inquired if it was ok for items that were approved for disposal at the last meeting, be placed in the Goodwill disposal box in Margate.

Acting Clerk Strawder stated a correction on the agenda for the meeting "Financial Report Summary" should be deleted as it was an error.

Mr. Carter stated he distributed a memo to the Governing Body approx. a month and a half ago a resident's request to improve a street end at 28th Ave. at his request. All improvements, i.e. landscaping, improve it, working on the bulkhead, will be at the resident's expense. Mr. Agnellini stated it is in the area of Ocean Plaza moving beach access steps from the north side to the south side. Mr. Agnellini will follow-up.

ORDINANCES- 2ND READING

O2012-10 AMENDING CHAPTER 161-VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC AS IT PERTAINS TO STOP SIGNS
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

SECTION 1: The following stop intersection in Chapter 161-17. Schedule 5. Stop Intersections is revised to read as follows:

Intersection

24th Avenue and Oberon Avenue

Location of Signs

Stop signs on 24th Avenue (Northbound and Southbound) and on Oberon Avenue (Westbound))

SECTION II: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies, are hereby repealed. Should any section, subsection, clause, or portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction as invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by Law.

SECTION IV: The Certification from the Municipal Engineer is attached hereto.

RESOLUTIONS

R2012-69 AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNING BODY TO CONVENE INTO AN EXECUTIVE SESSION

(7) ANY PENDING OR ANTICIPATED LITIGATION OR CONTRACT NEGOTIATION WHICH THE PUBLIC BODY IS, OR MAY BECOME A PARTY. ANY MATTER FALLING WITHIN THE ATTORNEY-CLIENT PRIVILEGE, TO THE EXTENT THAT CONFIDENTIALITY IS REQUIRED IN ORDER FOR THE ATTORNEY TO EXERCISE HIS ETHICAL DUTIES AS A LAWYER.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the discussion conducted in this session be disclosed at such time as the need for confidentiality is no longer needed.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconstant herewith are hereby repealed and this resolution shall take effect immediately.

Mayor Russo made motion to approve R2012-69 and seconded by Commissioner Leeds. MOTION APPROVED.

The containment system is a problem. The Mayor agreed and stated that the residents have been patient with the ongoing work.
