

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70-2. Certificate Required

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide certain documentation to the Borough for the transfer of real estate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

Section 70-2 is hereby amended as follows:

A certificate of land use compliance shall be required prior to the sale, transfer of title on a property through an LLC or any other means, construction, reconstruction, remodeling or alteration of any structure in the Borough of Longport. In Order for any such certificate to be issued in regards to the sale or transfer of title on a property, the Building Inspector and/or their designee must be provided proof of the actual sale price of the property including, but not limited to, sales effectuated by the transfer of ownership in an LLC or other entity.

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO A NON FAIR AND OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ARH ASSOCIATES OF HAMMONTON, N,J FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT PHASE II-INSTALLATION OF NEW WELL AND WELL BUILDING AT THE PUBLIC WORKS COMPLEX - 31st and Devon Avenues

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport has allocated Capital Improvement Funding for completion of the installation of a new well at the Longport Public Works Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport previously awarded a Non Fair and Open Professional Services Contract to ARH Associates per Resolution 2020-059 for the Phase II Design and Construction Management for the Installation of the Well and Well Building in the amount of \$192,000.00 pursuant to the provisions of NJSA 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the design process, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection required the submission of an additional B4B Discharge Permit relating to the discharge from well development as explained in the Extra Work Proposal from ARH Associates dated August 14, 2020 and attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Professional Service Fee requested in said Extra Work Proposal is for \$5,545.00, bringing the Total Professional Fee Service to a Not to Exceed \$197,545.00; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of said Services is not for more than one year; and
