This meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Law. Notices of this meeting were emailed to The Current and The Press of Atlantic City on March 24, 2021. In addition, copies of notices were posted on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk. Notices on the bulletin board have remained continuously posted. Official Action May be Taken at this Meeting.

This meeting will be held inside Commission Chambers and is open to the public. Face coverings will be required to enter Borough Hall and seating will be spaced to maintain 6 feet social distancing. Established guidelines for room capacity will be enforced in the event that the number of attendees exceeds permitted capacity. Capacity for members of the public is 37 persons.

During the workshop meeting remote participants will be on mute and there is no opportunity for the public to speak. During the regular meeting phone participants will be on mute until the parts of the meeting designated for public comment as listed on the agenda. Those participating who exceed the limit or are found to be disruptive of meeting proceedings will have their microphone muted. Members of the public that are attending remotely that wish to submit public comments and/or questions in advance of the meeting must provide that information by 12 noon the day preceding the Board of Commissioners Meeting. Comment/ questions must not exceed the three minute limitation when read aloud during the meeting. Duplicate questions will be addressed as one, and comments may be summarized. **A Resolution Authorizing the State of New Jersey to Enforce the Elevator Subcode**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Longport no longer finds it feasible to enforce the Elevator Sub Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Longport had contracted with the City of Atlantic City to perform this function; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlantic City has stopped performing this function as of March 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Longport shall and hereby gives the State of New Jersey Elevator Safety Unit jurisdiction as of April 1, 2021, to enforce the Elevator Sub Code; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Borough of Longport, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that as of April 1, 2021, the City of Atlantic City Elevator Sub Code Official will no longer enforce the Elevator Sub Code.
