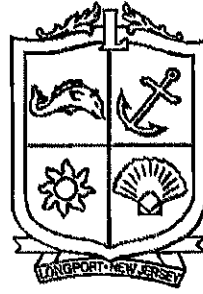

ORDINANCE 2023-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART I | ARTICLE IX SECTION 161-14

Borough of Longport Code Provision Chapter 161-14 is hereby amended as follows:

§ 161-14 Schedule 2: Limited Time and Angled Parking.

[Amended 5-19-1993 by Ord. No. 93-10; 5-18-1994 by Ord. No. 94-14; 6-1-1994 by Ord. No. 94-15; 7-16-1997 by Ord. No. 97-16; 1-19-2000 by Ord. No. 99-15; 7-17-2006 by Ord. No. 2006-11; 9-3-2008 by Ord. No. 2008-12; 6-7-2009 by Ord. No. 2009-16]

No person shall park a vehicle longer than the time limit indicated within this schedule. Where also indicated, no person shall park a vehicle except at an angle where indicated in this schedule. Where a time limit is indicated but there is no indication of permitted angled parking, it shall be interpreted that the parking shall be parallel with the existing curbing.

ORDINANCE 2023-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART II CHAPTERS 111-20.1 AND 111-28

Borough of Longport Code Provision Chapters §111-20 and §111-28 are hereby amended as follows:

§ 111-20.1 **Commercial landscapers.**

[Added 3-19-1997 by Ord. No. 97-09]

A. Definitions. As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated:

COMMERCIAL LANDSCAPER

A person or entity whose business involves the placing, planting, arranging, trimming, cutting and removing of trees and the maintenance of lawns, trees, bushes, shrubs, gardens and related appurtenances on land or property for any purpose.

VEHICLE Every device in, upon or by which a person or property is or may be transported upon a highway.

B. Permit application information. The application for a permit to operate or conduct business as a commercial landscaper in the Borough of Longport shall be made in writing, signed by the applicant and submitted to the Borough Construction Code Department. The application shall include the following information:

- (1)** The name, address and telephone number of the applicant.
- (2)** The character and type of substance, e.g., grass clipping, brush, twigs or leaves that the applicant will be dumping in his or her operation.
- (3)** The location where the debris is to be taken and the name and telephone number of the company or organization to receive such debris.

C. Operating requirements. Every commercial landscaper operating within the Borough of Longport shall be required to comply with the following:

- (1)** The name of the landscaping company shall be clearly indicated on both sides of any vehicle used in said operation, shall be no less than three inches in height and shall include the address and telephone number.

(2) Tags identifying that vehicles have been properly registered must be displayed on each vehicle.

(3) The use of backpack blowers used for the purposes of spreading and blowing about grass, leaves and other debris shall be prohibited. The use of hand-held grass blowers and leaf blowers shall be permitted, subject to compliance with the following conditions:

(a) All sidewalk clippings shall be dispersed back onto the homeowner's lawn.

(b) All gutters shall be swept and shoveled.

(c) Hand-held blowers shall not be used in gutters or streets.

(d) Storm drains shall be covered while working in the immediate vicinity.

(e) All leaves, twigs and clippings must be properly bagged and taken to the Atlantic County Municipal Utilities Authority plant for processing, or otherwise legally disposed of in accordance with state and local laws and other applicable regulations

(4) All vehicles used in landscaping operations shall be required to utilize a cover on said vehicles to prevent any clipping, leaves, twigs or other debris from blowing out of the vehicle when traveling in the streets of the Borough of Longport.

(5) Commercial landscapers shall not place clippings, twigs or leaves at the curb. This material must be properly removed by the commercial landscaper.

~~(6) Commercial landscapers shall be permitted to engage in the landscaping business during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday; and 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturdays. No work shall be permitted on Sundays except as otherwise directed by the Police Department.~~

(1) [Year-round rule: Commercial Landscaping shall be permitted Monday through Friday throughout the year between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. No landscaping shall be permitted on Sundays or the following holidays: New Year's Day; Memorial Day weekend (Saturday, Sunday and Monday); July 4 (If July 4 falls on a Monday or Friday, then Saturday is also a prohibited day. If July 4 falls on a weekend then no landscaping shall be permitted on the day of observance whether the Friday before or Monday after the weekend); Labor Day weekend (Saturday, Sunday and Monday); Thanksgiving Day; Christmas Day.

(2) Summer Saturday Rule: Saturday landscaping shall be permitted during the period June 15 to September 15, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

(3) Winter Saturday rule: Saturday landscaping shall be permitted during the period September 16 to June 14 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.,

- (4) Emergency exception: in the case of urgent necessity in the interest of public health and safety, and then only with a permit from the Construction Code Official, which permit may be granted for a period not to exceed three days while the emergency continues and which permit may be renewed for a period of three days or less while the emergency continues or except as otherwise directed by the Police Department.]
- (5) The use of lawnmowers, chainsaws and grass blowers powered by internal combustion engines other than during the prescribed hours shall constitute a violation of this article.

§ 111-28 Violations and penalties.

Any person violating any provision of this article shall, upon conviction in the Municipal Court of the Borough of Longport, be subject to a fine not to exceed \$200 [\$1000.00] or imprisonment in the county jail for any term not to exceed 90 days, or both, in the discretion of the Municipal Magistrate [Judge] hearing the same.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW
JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT EMERGENCY
OPERATIONS PLAN (EOP)**

WHEREAS, the purpose of the EOP is to develop a comprehensive emergency management program that will provide a system to mitigate the effects of an emergency or disaster, preserve life, respond during emergencies, provide necessary assistance, and establish a recovery system, in order to return the community to its normal state of affairs; and

WHEREAS, this plan attempts to clearly define the roles and responsibilities of each department and function within the Borough organization by providing guidance in accomplishing the objectives of this plan with lists of guidelines, plans, assessments and resources; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2003, the President issued Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD) - 5 Management of Domestic Incidents, which directs the Secretary of Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the directive also requires Federal Departments and agencies to make adoption of the NIMS by State, Tribal, and local organizations a condition for Federal preparedness assistance beginning in Federal FY 2005; and

WHEREAS, certain State and Federal disaster reimbursements require local jurisdictions to adopt and train in a EOP, NIMS, and Incident Command Systems (ICS); and

WHEREAS, certain Federal and State grant programs now require an adopted EOP; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Emergency Management Coordinator and the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) have reviewed the updated Emergency Operations Plan with all of its attachments as periodically amended by the EMC, and recommends adoption by the Borough Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the Borough of Longport to formally adopt them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Longport, New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION. The Emergency Operations Plan, dated July 10, 2023, along with all appendices, as periodically amended by the Office of Emergency Management, are hereby adopted, to replace any and all others previously adopted plans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forthwith transmitted to the Borough of Longport Office of Emergency Management.

Resolution to Extend 3rd Quarter 2023 Tax Due Date

WHEREAS, delays by the State of New Jersey have delayed the issuance of tax bills for the year of 2023 and preliminary 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport in Atlantic County that pursuant to R.S. 54:4-67 the rate of interest to be charged for the non-payment of taxes and/or assessments on or before the date when they would become delinquent, is hereby fixed at eight (8%) percent per annum on the first \$1,500 of the delinquency and eighteen (18%) percent per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500 to be calculated from the date the tax was payable until the date of actual payment, provided however, that no interest shall be charged if payment of any installment is made within twenty two (22) days after the date upon which the same became payable (August 1, 2023) with a grace period extended through August 22, 2023.
