ORDINANCE 2023-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II SECTION 161-4.9

Borough of Longport Code Provision Article II Section 161-4.9 is hereby amended as follows:

§ 161-4.9 Designation of parking areas for municipal vehicles.

[Added 7-17-2006 by Ord. No. 2006-11]

Discretionary parking within established parking areas limited to municipal vehicles only may be approved and regulated through written consent of both the Longport Chief of Police and at least one Borough Commissioner.

[The Borough shall establish designated Employee Only parking spaces behind Borough Hall for the exclusive use by Borough employees between the hours of 9:00AM to 5:00PM Monday through Friday. Employees entitled to such parking will be issued an identification placard or sticker for their vehicle. The Employee Only parking spaces shall be identified by signage indicating parking for employees only. Any vehicle parked in an Employee Only designated spot without an identification placard or sticker is subject to penalties as set forth in the provisions of Article II of this Chapter. The Borough Commissioners shall set the number of Employee Only parking spaces by Resolution. The Chief of Police in consultation with the Borough Administrator shall identify the spaces behind Borough Hall to be designated for Employee Only parking.]

Part I CHAPTER 42-3 is hereby amended as follows:

§ 42-3 Fees for copies.

- [C. If the actual cost to produce paper copies exceeds the above rates; the Borough may charge the actual cost of duplication.
- **D.** The Borough shall provide electronic records free of charge. (i.e. records sent via e-mail and fax).]

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 57 SECTIONS 18 and 19

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

Borough of Longport Code Provision Chapter 57 Sections 18 and 19, addressing alcoholic beverages in the Borough, is hereby amended as follows:

§ 57-18 Regulations.

[Amended 3-22-2017 by Ord. No. 2017-08]

No person shall, on any public or quasi-public property, in or not in a private conveyance, within the Borough of Longport:

- A. Consume any alcoholic beverage.
- B. Be in possession of an opened or unsealed container of any alcoholic beverage.
- **C.** The foregoing restrictions shall not apply to alcoholic beverages sold or sampled at the Longport Farmer's Market [or at Longport Borough special events] provided all applicable permits and authorizations have been obtained.

§ 57-19 Violations and penalties.

[A violation of Sections 17 - 19 constitutes a breach of the peace.] Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 \$1,000.00 or a jail term in the county jail not to exceed 90 days 6 months, or both, at the discretion of the sentencing judge, and each day that the violation under this article shall continue shall be deemed a separate violation under this article.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 61 SECTIONS 6 and 8

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

Borough of Longport Code Provision Chapter 61 Sections 6 Q and 8, addressing the Borough's regulation of Beaches, Parks, Recreational Areas and Facilities, is hereby amended as follows:

§ 61-6 Rules and regulations.

[Amended 5-4-1983]

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in any of the following acts or conduct during the bathing season or at other times if so specified herein:

Q. (Reserved)^[1] [add – Any gathering of 10 or more minors not accompanied by a parent or legal guardian of one of the minors between the hours of 8:00 PM and 5:00 AM. This provision is in addition to and supplements Code Chapter 78 Sections 1-6 – Curfew].

[1] Editor's Note: Former Subsection Q, regarding flying of kites, was repealed 5-17-2017 by Ord. No. 2017-12.

§ 61-8 Violations and penalties.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article or any of the rules and regulations adopted hereunder shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not more than \$500 or to imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

[A violation of this Section constitutes a breach of the peace. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or a jail term in the county jail not to exceed 6 months, or both, at the discretion of the sentencing judge, and each day that the violation under this article shall continue shall be deemed a separate violation under this article]
