BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that all rules, regulations, resolutions, statements of policy, educational goals and curriculum and other actions passed, adopted, promulgated, or otherwise, by the preceding Board of Education of Longport New Jersey, except those which expired by their own terms, and adopted by this reference thereunto by the present LONGPORT BOARD OF EDUCATION organized on January 10, 2019.

SCHOOL BOARD CODE OF ETHICS Motion made by Mr. Tripician, seconded by Mrs. Affanato, to accept the School Board Code of Ethics:

WHEREAS, the Longport Board of Education must discuss and adopt the Code of Ethics for School Board Members, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-21 et seq. and

WHEREAS, the Longport Board of Education must adopt policies and procedures regarding the training of its members in understanding of that Code of Ethics

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the New Jersey School Board Member Code of Ethics, be adopted along with the policies and procedures for training.
