ESTABLISHMENT OF AN EMERGENCY ‘NO PARKING’ AREA, CLOSURE,
AND DETOURING**

WHEREAS, the Longport Police Department has been requested to block off 24th and Oberon to both pedestrian and traffic for two days, specifically October 4 and October 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the request is for the safety and welfare of pedestrians and traffic during the replacement of the roof at the Winchester House; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:197.3, a Municipality has the right to permit special traffic regulations when circumstances of this type dictate its necessity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Borough of Longport that it hereinafter authorizes the following temporary special traffic regulations, including but not limited to the closing and detouring of traffic and pedestrians, to be implemented by the Longport Police Department in the Borough of Longport, Atlantic County, New Jersey:

'No Parking/No Pedestrians' east side of 24th Ave from the southerly curb line of Oberon Ave to a point 115 feet southerly there from

“No Parking/No Pedestrians” on the Southside of Oberon Ave- from the Easterly curb line of 24th Avenue to a point 100 feet easterly therefrom

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prohibition of parking shall expire upon completion of the aforesaid construction.
