BOROUGH OF LONGPORT RESOLUTION 2016-13

Authorizing Surfrider Foundation to Place Monofilament Recycling Receptacles in the Borough of Longport

WHEREAS, members of the Surfrider Foundation have requested that the Governing Body authorize the installation of monofilament recycling receptacles at certain prime fishing areas in the Borough of Longport; and

WHEREAS, the proposed receptacles are made of four (4) inch PVC pipe, each two (2) foot long with an elbow on top. The bottom has a threaded adapter for a plug. The plug has a ¼ inch hole to allow for water to drain. The unit is mounted vertically below a weatherproof sign;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body agrees with the Surfrider Foundation that this program will benefit the community by protecting the bay and ocean from pollution, and keep areas clean and safe. Monofilament is known to entangle wildlife and humans, and takes about five hundred (500) years to degrade; and

WHEREAS, volunteers from Tackle Direct and Surfrider will be responsible for emptying, cleaning and repairing all receptacles and collected monofilament line will be sent to Berkeley Line Company for recycling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Longport Commission that Surfrider Foundation is authorized to install three (3) monofilament receptacles, at no cost to the Borough of Longport, on existing sign poles at the following locations:

- A. 11th Street and the jetty;
- B. Fishing pier behind Borough of Longport Hall
