Whereas, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2016 Statewide Crackdown*; and

Whereas, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 19 through September 5; and

Whereas, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways;

Therefore, be is resolved that the Borough of Longport declares it's support for the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2016 Statewide Crackdown* from August 19 through September 5, 2016 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
