A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FEMA) HIGH WATER MARK (HWM) INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport has established the Community Rating System (CRS) Assistance Program to encourage Borough participation and advancement in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) CRS Program; and

WHEREAS; the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) offers limited financial assistance to communities that want to raise flood risk awareness and conduct mitigation actions to protect the public from future flood events, including by posting high water mark signs that acknowledge the location of historic flood events; and

WHEREAS; the Borough will identify the proper location for the high water mark signs and will support public outreach and program launch events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of the Borough of Longport authorize participation in the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) High Water Mark Initiative (HWM) as a partner community and agrees to place four (4) commemorative signs within the municipality at the following locations: 1) At the Gazebo at 17th Street, Block 12, Lot 12.01; 2) At the Longport Historical Society, Block 19, Lot 11; 3) At the Gazebo at 35th Street, Block 101, Lot 1; and 4), In the 29th Street Ventnor Avenue Park, Block 36.01, Lot 1.
