BOROUGH OF LONGPORT COUNTY OF ATLANTIC ORDINANCE NO. 2018-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 161 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," SECTION 14.1 SCHEDULE 2A, "HANDICPPED PARKING" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT, ATLANTIC COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to make amend the Borough of Longport's Code to reflect changes in Handicapped Parking Spaces Schedule 2A.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

SECTION I: Chapter 161 "Vehicles and Traffic," Section 14.1 Schedule 2A "Handicapped Parking" of the Code of the Borough of Longport is deleted in its' entirety and is replaced as follows:

"§ 161-14.1**Schedule 2A: Handicapped Parking.**[Added 6-2-1993 by Ord. No. 93-13; Amended 08-08-18 by Ord No. 2018-XX]

A.

The following locations are hereby designated as restricted parking spaces for use by persons who have been issued special vehicle identification cards by the Division of Motor Vehicles. No other person shall be permitted to park in these spaces: [Amended 7-21-1993 by Ord. No.93-17; 7-19-1995 by Ord. No. 95-06; 7-19-2000 by Ord. No. 1000-6; 8-4-2004 by Ord. No. 2004-16]

B.

In addition to the penalty imposed for the violation of any of the provisions of this article of any vehicles parked in violation of any of the provisions of this article, the Police Department may cause said vehicle to be removed to such place as designated by the Chief of Police. The owner or operator of such vehicle so removed shall pay the reasonable cost and expense of such removal and the storage which may result therefrom, and any person, firm or corporation desiring to reclaim such vehicle may do so by paying the expenses of such removal, storage and violation.

C.

In addition to any other penalties herein provided, any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon the conviction thereof by the Municipal Court, be punishable by a penalty of \$100 first offense; subsequent offenses to be \$100 minimum and/or up to 90 days' community service."

SECTION II: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies, are hereby repealed. Should any section, subsection, clause, or portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction as invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by Law.
